

Referring to the NRM

A referral for an adult (18 yrs and above) requires consent. A duty to notify is mandatory without consent.

<p>What has happened which had led to referral being made?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Why are you making the referral? • Has anybody else raised concerns with you? • What type of exploitation/modern slavery are you concerned about? E.g. sexual exploitation, forced criminality, slavery.....
<p>Refer to page 37 of the home office guidance for list of indicators: https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/modern-slavery-guidance</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Which indicators have you identified? • Which indicators are suspected? • Which indicators are confirmed? • Are there other indicators than those on the list?
<p>Structure of referral:</p> <p>Tip: the online referral form does time out</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Write this as a chronology of key events, concerns, and indicators. When did the concerns start? Are they ongoing/still present? Dates are useful. • What significant events have happened? Who reported them? • Locations where exploitation has taken place. Your professional opinion is important so please capture this in referral. • Ensure ALL exploitation/modern slavery concerns are captured (current and historic).
<p>Vulnerabilities:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Include any information in relation to vulnerabilities of the person/young person – for example mental health, learning needs, diagnoses. • Be clear why you are including these vulnerabilities.
<p>Remember the definitions: Trafficking: Three main components: Act, Means, Purpose Modern Slavery Statutory Guidance: Here Pg 18 You DO NOT require means for a child (under 18)</p> <p>Slavery, Servitude, Forced/Compulsory Labour: Means, Service : Pg 31</p>	<p>Trafficking: ACT: recruit, transport, transfer, harbour, receive. MEANS: Threat or use of force, coercion, deception, fraud, abduction, abuse of power PURPOSE: Exploitation Type: Criminal, Sexual, forced labour, Domestic servitude, organ harvesting</p> <p>SSFCL: MEANS: As above SERVICE: E.G: begging, sexual services, manual labour, domestic services</p>
